
state and I'm happy I'll be the state President at that time. I promise to give total cooperation to the national IMA on all constructive issues of mutual interest.


The WHO (World Health Organization) observes ▲ many health campaigns and World AIDS Day is one of the most widely known campaigns. The world has accepted to observe World AIDS Day on 1st of December every year from 1988. On this day, discussions about HIV/AIDS (Acquired Immuno Deficiency Syndrome) and speeches will organised bv community organisations(CBO), government and nongovernment organizations(NGO), individuals and health officials across the globe to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS pandemic. In this article we enlighten the theme for this year and role of IMA and its members.

There are more advancements in the management of HIV/AIDS, but we still get new infections. There is a need for the public to protect themselves and others. We require continuous awareness camps and screening of the population. For this the memory of HIV/AIDS should stay persistently in the people's mind. Hence the World AIDS Day observations are necessary to keep the disease in the lime light. It will help to control the disease by increasing awareness and indirectly improves the health and quality of life of the citizens.

HIV/AIDS is still one of the devastating pandemic the world has ever seen. Globally, at present, nearly 38 million people are living with the virus and equal number has lost their lives since the virus was isolated in 1984. Indistinguishably, the virus has no difference between age groups, ethnicity, professions, economic status etc.,

The virus keeps spreading from one infected person to another by one of the following methods.

- 1) Sexual route (All types Hetero and Homo)
- 2) Mother to child during pregnancy and breastfeeding



- 3) Blood, blood products and body parts (Donor to recipient)
- 4) Others like IV drug abuse (needle sharing, accidental pricks etc).

The most common method of transmission is sexual route and the most efficient route of transmission is through blood and blood products.

Previously we found more opportunistic infections (OI) in HIV patients, but now a days it is rare to see OI, thanks to our Governments for giving Anti Retroviral Treatment (ART) free of cost to all the citizens with HIV infection.

Controlling HIV pandemic is the collective responsibility of the Government and the Public. The government should ensure uniformity, standard operating procedures (SOP), and workers should understand their responsibilities and work carefully to bring more efficiency in controlling the disease. Government agencies should also be user and patient friendly and avoid duplications in line listing of positive patients.

Public, should avoid social stigma and discrimination of people living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA). PLHAs should come out of this stigma and disrespect by the society and disease. PLHAs should take responsibility and help the agencies for contact tracing and to control the disease.

This year theme is Global solidarity and shared responsibility. As explained the responsibility should be shared by all, the Governments and the Public.

As a member of IMA, we will take an oath that we won't stigmatise or discriminate PLHAs. In blood banks, sexual history of the donor is must, to select the donor. It will help to filter the donors who are in the window period. Tips for the General practitioners, screen all the partner(s) of a positive patient. If the patient is a female patient, screen all her children also for this dreadful disease. Obstetricians should screen all the pregnant women and their spouses during the first and last trimester. If you are referring, keep necessary records. In our practice we should be mindful and help the Government in contact tracing. Before doing the HIV test, pre test counseling and informed consent are necessary.

If the test is found positive, give post test counseling and refer them to the nearby Integrated Counseling and Testing Centres (ICTC). In Tamilnadu we have 2163 ICTCs which are located in various places from Primary

Health Centres (PHCs) to Medical College hospitals. In ICTCs, they use three different tests to confirm and detect three antigens for HIV. Hence it is equal to western blot test and confirmatory.

In ICTC they will confirm and refer the patient to nearby ART centre if found positive. There are 57 ART centres in Tamilnadu depending on the population. From 2017, "Test and Treat" policy is followed – irrespective of patient's immune status all are started on ART as early as possible.

Conclusion:

As per the 2020 theme "Global solidarity and shared responsibility" – to show our solidarity, we take a pledge to stop stigma and discrimination against HIV/AIDS and will take responsibility in all possible ways to decrease the burden to the nation.



Dear Dear colleagues of IMA TNSB and brothers and sisters of FSS,

Warm greetings to you all.

Even though there is new hope for better future about the Chinese Covid-19 pandemic, warning about the increase in incidence of infection due to the forth coming festival seasons, from The Honorable Prime Minister himself down to other higher officials in control of infection, is there. One sentence in the Govt. message he hear in our cell phone on making a call is important -"Even slight carelessness in our preventive measures may lead to grave consequences". So we have to continue with PPE, and other measures with vigilance.

The present scenario calls for an urgent action by all concerned with FSS. As you all know, Chinese Covid-19 has done enormous damage to the country's economy and carried away many precious lives of our members. On date 21 of our members have lost their life due to covid-19. Total number of our members died during this year ie.25th premium is 105 on

date. Unexpected Covid-19 deaths have put a strain on the scheme.

In FSS II, there are enough funds to manage the situation.

You must have read the TIMA Bulletin of Oct.2020 where we have given how much FSS - I has contributed for extra deaths in the previous years 2018, 2019 and so far in this year 2020 for deaths over 70 (for 32 over and above 70).

As you are aware, we are collecting Rs.14,000/- as 25th premium of this year for expected 70 deaths. There are already 32 more deaths and we have still 2 months to go for completion. In the 62nd Management Committee meeting, held last November 2019, resolution was passed to raise the 25th premium to Rs.14,000/- with the option to collect extra amount if death exceeds 70. So we have to collect for extra deaths now. which could not be avoided.

In view of short time to intimate and start collecting the amount separately, we submitted a proposal - to collect the next 26th Premium from

November 2020 itself at the premium of Rs.200X100 = 20,000/- covering the increased death rate, to the State Council of our IMA TNSB on 1st November 2020, and honorable members were kind enough to accept our urgent request. This will be placed in the forthcoming FSS management committee meeting for ratification. We thank IMA TNSB for the same.

We have put up this in our 'whatsup' and we thankful to some of our members who have readily paid the 26th premium of Rs.20,000/-

We are submitting a proposal to the FSS Management Committee to be held on 19.11.2020 for extending the 10% reduction in NRD amount to be paid by newly joining members for one more month ie. for the month of January 2021.

IMA TNSB and FSS feel inner satisfaction of helping our colleague's families, especially of those members whose demise was sudden and unexpected.

It is time to adopt benevolent attitude to the bereaved families of our demised colleagues with more enthusiasm.



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
