#### Dear Friends,

It gives me great pleasure to address you for one more time as your State President.

It is quite relieving to see that the pandemic has been slowing down and there has been a tremendous decline in number of cases per day. I hope that we will continue our safety precautions and keep the third wave at bay. In this context, I would request the state and central governments to let IMA shoulder the responsibility of vaccination of the population, that too free of charge.

This month we have seen hectic activity with management committee meetings of the wings and schemes. There has been a lot of discussion going on in social media about FSS premium especially this year. We must all realize that the years 2020 –2021 have been very hard on our profession and we have already lost more than 175 members. I would like to mention that for the last 4 years, we have not collected any additional advance for the additional deaths. This year we have collected Rs. 20000/- for 100 deaths. Because of the unforeseen circumstances we are compelled to collect Rs.15000/ as additional advance for 75 deaths for further payment.

I hope by God's grace we will not see another year like this and the AFC would naturally come down. I appreciate the concern expressed by our members and some alternatives have also been offered. The best way to discuss this, will be by attending the next FSS general body, in good numbers, hopefully in person and submitting your constructive views. A new team has taken over in both PPLSSS and FSS I expect a lot of energy from them.

I'm happy that issues were discussed in NHB management committee meeting but it's clear that they need a full day for discussion which may be possible if the pandemic subsides.

I take this opportunity to thank the state government for recognising our services by conducting the Doctors day celebration and I'm proud to say that we were the first to

be called for the award. This government has been sympathetic to our profession and first it was solatium and now the awards. I hope this goodwill will continue in the coming years also.

I congratulate IMA CVB Theni for conducting the state council meeting in a grand and purposeful manner. Though declared as a hybrid meeting ultimately it resembled a full in person meeting. I thank all the members who participated for their interest in the welfare of IMA. Though there were heated discussions ultimately it was in the interest of IMA and many useful resolutions were passed. I take this opportunity to thank all the past state Presidents who participated in the forum meeting for giving very helpful suggestions to me and the state office.

I congratulate NHB for coming out with a comprehensive app covering all NHB members. Hope our members will find it useful when put to use.

I'm immensely happy that our national president Dr. J. A. Jayalal could find time to spend with us and give useful inputs. I take this opportunity to thank him and national IMA for giving solatium of ten lakhs each to four families from Tamil Nadu.

# Dear Seniors, Friends and Colleagues,

On behalf of IMA Cumbum Valley branch and Mullai Periyar branch, I would like to thank our President Dr. P. Ramakrishnan and the State Secretary Dr. A.K. Ravikumar for having given us the opportunity to host the State Council Meeting in

Madurai. We'd like to thank you for participating and making it special and memorable for all of us.

I'd like to give a short glimpse into the financials of the last one and a half years.

When we tookover on 1.1. 2020 the number of FD's was 114 with Rs. 52914951 as deposits spread over 7 banks in various places

Now, we have 44 FD's. 16 of them named FD's, the others have been amalgamated and we are under the process to make it just 22 FD's all in one bank in Coimbatore.

We have created one new FD for Rs 32,00,000 in this period.

We have 19 bank accounts, 3 of them (UNICEF, CGP, AMS) have no transactions and 3 (PPLSSS, FSS, NHB, benevolent fund) have income only. The TNSB share from FSS, PPLSSS (Rs.1000 per



member) and NHB (Rs. 1500 per member). The major revenues for IMA TNSB is from

- 1.Membership
- 2. Donations for the action fund
- 3.FSS 1000 per enrolment
- 4.PPLSSS 1000 per enrolment
- 5.NHB 1500 per enrolment
- 6. Academic cell Registration and course fee Rs. 25,000 / Rs. 15,000 per student.
- 7. Paramedical wing Inspection fees Rs. 3000 per course and Accreditation certification fees Rs. 5000 / Rs. 10000 (for 3 yrs) per course, Admission fee Rs. 1000 per student per year& exam fee Rs. 200/- per paper.
- 8.TIMA advertisement revenues.
- 9. We are on a surplus as far as the NATCON account is concerned, which we will be transferring to our main account.
- 10. The benevolent fund receives Rs. 75 per member and Rs. 200 per couple member.

The final closing balance as on 31.05.2021 is Rs. 1,10,93,401/-

# As per IMA TNSB Constitution - Rules & Bye Laws (Revised - September 2019) Page No. 36 ELIGIBILITY OF THE CANDIDATES : GENERAL :

- 1. Only life members are eligible to be Office Bearers for any posts.
- $2.\,Each\,post\,shall\,demand\,a\,particular\,period\,of\,continuous\,life\,membership.$
- 3. Elections shall be conducted once in 2 years by the Election Commission.
- 4. The proposal shall be forwarded by the branch office bearers (President and Secretary) and should carry proposal and seconding from two other life members of the same branch.
- 5. The nomination should be accompanied by a "Consent Letter by self" from the candidate in his letter head.
- 6. The candidate shall enter factual details only. Attempts to give wrong information/or hide information shall invite disqualification.
- $7. \, The \, application \, shall \, carry \, correct \, fee \, as \, Demand \, draft \, (only).$

- 8. The application shall reach the state office within the stipulated time and date.
- 9. The application with an image of the Demand Draft may be sent as a soft copy from his/her personal registered email id in case any reasonable postal/courier delay is expected. But it should be followed by the original application and should match each other.
- 10. In exceptional cases, the application may be handed over in person but should get a receipt for the same stating the time and date.
- 11. Past State Presidents cannot contest any post except CWC Regular Member Post

As per Resolution passed in 74<sup>th</sup> AGM at Trichy: It is resolved to pass that the authorised signatories whose names figure in the current investigation into misappropriation of funds are requested not to contest the elections until the investigation is completed.

As per Resolution passed in 305th SCM at Kodaikanal through online: When there is a due in State branch or local branch, one cannot contest election either in local branch or state branch.

As per Resolution passed in 308<sup>th</sup> SCM at Tex Valley, Erode: A resolution passed that a member whose name appear in the charge sheet, not to contest the elections of IMA TNSB on moral grounds.

This program is being conducted for one hour once a week and pregnant mothers are given activities by Prenatal Counsellor and members of Women Doctors Wing of IMA Coimbatore Branch.

**Day 1**: They were asked to write the blessing in their life – atleast ten. This helped them realize their strength and helped them to focus. Because knowing oneself is the beginning of all wisdom as stated by Aristole.

Day 2: They were asked to write the desires for their baby in places where they could easily see it often as in mirror or bedroom wall. This constant wish will have a positive input on the baby. Medication for first five minutes soon after getting up was also taught.

Day 3: They were asked to observe their activity for 24 hrs. That helped them to kow if they wre idling or spending usefully as in walk, rest, cooking, listening to music, doing the dishes etc.

Day 4: They wrote gratitude not to their parents and were so happy to note the joy of their parents. All these days they were at the receiving end and realized that giving back is more important.

They also wrote gratitude not to frontlines and all

those associated with them in their life.

**Day 5**: Gratitude to all haters. This made them know their negatives, to correct them and grow.

**Day 6**: Gratitude to pregnancy and husband. Usually in our families, we don't use thank you, please sorry etc, stating it makes the relationship format. But many of the Antenatal mothers were pleases to note that their husband was so happy where they gave them the thank you note.

This small act of kindness had brought them closer creating a better bonding.

Dr. Sasithra spoke on Epigenetics on that day. She retold the story of Prahaladha and how the child in the womb was influenced by Narayana Nama.

That showed how prenatal music and book creations like book reading, starting a collection of books or library can influence the baby later on.

Day 7: They were asked to write poems to their baby and keeping a hand on the abdomen, recite it to them. Their voice become familiar and the child – mother bonding is strengthened. This is proven by the fact that however a child crisis, it can be smoothened by his mother's voice.

On that day Dr. Anitha spoke on avoiding junk foods, nutritious, balanced diet, good sleep, avoiding electronic gadgets later in the night which can help them be early risers. Only then such self discipline will be inculcated in the baby too. And also to wear loose fitting clothes, avoiding loggings.

Our appeal to all Branch Presidents and Secretaries, kindly motivate your colleagues and branch IMA members to join the IMA CGP to get all the benefits of being a member of this College of General Practitioners.

I thank our IMA State President and State Secretary, IMA office bearers and State Council Members for approving the following courses to conduct in a successful way.

To channelize and to properly organize our IMA TNSB CGP courses the following decision were taken:

- ▶ The eligibility to join the CGP courses must have a minimum MBBS, and membership in IMA & CGP.
- ▶ One person can register in 2 courses maximum at a time without interfering with the attendance.
- ► One person can undergo any number of courses
- ▶ Duration of the courses will be 6 months
- ▶ All the courses will be mainly by Virtual classes and intermittent hands on training and contact classes.
- ► There will be a project given to each in the 4<sup>th</sup> month of the course which they have to finish at the end of 5<sup>th</sup> month.
- ▶ During the whole of training period of 6 months, a log book should be maintained by everyone, which will be assessed at the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> month.

#### Respected Senior Medical Professionals, Beloved Colleagues, Dear Friends,

Best Wishes and Greetings from PPLSSS Team 2021 – 23. In April - May - June – TIMA News Bulletin, we have published the way how PPLSSS, HPS, FBS Schemes are functioning., by way of SOPs and Application forms for the above schemes. We hope, those are very useful for the members.

We are in the communication era, considering that in mind, members are requested to give correct Cell number & E.mail id, Landline members & complete Postal address, which are essential and mandatory for enrolling the membership.

Out of Lawyer Notices & Consumer Forum Notices, we noted many Hospitals & Doctors, are lacking enough Records, for defence. Inspite of your busy practice don't forget to write the Case sheets, Consent forms, Progress reports, Nurses reports, Drug charts, Fever charts. I/O charts, Operation Notes, Discharge Summary. Record any uncooperation by the patient & attenders in the case sheet with date & time.

If any patient is missing in the ward, record it, if you give permission for any patient, record it—mention the reason, and if any objection by you on medical grounds, please record it. Some of our colleagues (not everybody) sometimes, fabricate the case sheets—which will give a wrong figure at Courts & leading to loss of Victory in the case. If any rewriting or over writing, put your signature or initials for the corrections made.

Saving the Lives are important, So first attend patient – give the treatment – then record in the case sheet systematicaly. In one incident a patient was received at 01.05 am - Emergency treatment, Resuscitation & Stabilization done till 1.45 am - referred to GH at 2.10 am in Ambulance – referral letter with CT film only. But the CT report, Basic Lab reports, Bill & Receipts given to the attenders at 2.45 am, then recorded everything in the ER case sheet & discharge slip, but the Lawyer's accusation was What is the final diagnosis? – Why 1.30 hours to arrive a diagnosis? Why it was not recorded then & there while examining????.... At 2.45 am, When the patient not at all, at the treating hospital – How bill & receipts made after the patient being moved? Why reports given at a later time? So the Lawyer was saying that all are fabricated and only a after thought!!!. But it was not show.

Actually a probable Diagnosis & Differential Diagnosis was given while referring & after receiving Lab reports & CT report & Handed over to the waiting attenders. Medicines used from Emergency Room – Drug Trolly - were replaced from Pharmacy which was billed after the referral, given to the waiting attenders. So recording the case sheet & mentioning the facts is very important.

Do remember the words

"More Records = More Defence; Less Records = Less Defence; No Records = No Defence"
