Dear colleagues,

A recent proposal by the Central government to train AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy) doctors to perform surgeries, with the goal of increasing health personnel, has caused an uproar in all groups of allopathic doctors including in Indian Medical Association (IMA). It is sending shock waves among public who are already struggling to build trust with public healthcare professionals.

The IMA has proposed and carried out multiple protests and strictly which has condemned this act. The act by itself is processed with little thought and will form an adverse effect in public healthcare. Most AYUSH doctors primarily practice in urban areas and many have been accused of using antibiotics and steroids irrationally to treat a range of ailments without the necessary allopathic training. The primary fault lies upon us as practitioners and proprietors who has allowed AYUSH doctors to take-up administrative tasks in their health centres, and women AYUSH medics who are asked to get involved with prenatal checkups without the necessary training, because of a preference for 'lady doctors' in rural areas by pregnant women. Recognising this, the government in 2018 also issued a circular to upskill Ayurvedic, Unani and Homeopathic doctors in skilled birth attendant (SBA) training. A small step which we allowed has now been used as a foundation to open up more space for AYUSH doctors, now they are trying to enter into our operation theatres!

IMA is worry about khichdi training, a mishmash that works well for food, but not for education, producing substandard doctors. Substandard Doctors leads to bad practitioners and worse quality of care for patient. Already government policy permitting Ayurvedic practitioners to prescribe allopathic drugs in several states in India. If we allow this stand to continue then India will become on of the worst countries in regard to healthcare. We have no offence with regard to a AYUSH doctor's practice but allowing an unskilled labourer to perform a skilled job will lead to bad outcomes and when it is a matter of life and death of a patient the gamble our government is taking is shocking and scary. I humbly request all Doctors to stand together and oppose this crude law so that a safe healthcare solution for our citizens will be preserved.
